It's time to gather your friends and family and get ready for our 18th annual Table Rock Lake Shoreline Cleanup! This year, the first Saturday in April falls on April 7th.

since 2001 we have removed over 265 tons of trash and recycled over 4,500 tires from the shorelines of Table Rock Lake. These impressive results are only possible with the support and dedication of volunteers like you!

We need your continued support for the Cleanup again this year. Form a team, become a business sponsor (if not already), and help us continue to keep our lake clean and beautiful. If you are unable to organize a team, encourage a neighbor or friend to take the reins this year, and pass this information on to them. **We would also appreciate reports from you on any locations you are aware of that need some work.** You can contact us online at ozarkswaterwatch.org or call 417-739-5001.

Cleanup supplies are provided and will be ready for you to pick up starting March 26th (locations on reverse).

The Cleanup takes place anywhere along the almost 800 miles of shoreline. We've had over 100 teams and 1,000 volunteers some years, and hope to do it again! Teams are made up of families, businesses, home owners associations, church groups, student groups, scouts, etc. Your team can work morning, afternoon, another weekend, or during the week. (Roll-off dumpsters available Friday 4/6 – Monday 4/9) Choose a location you're familiar with, move to another location, or we can help you coordinate an area for your team to cleanup.

Use the *Volunteer and Trash Tracking Sheet* (included) to track your team and cleanup location for us! Please return the Volunteer and Trash Tracking Sheet to our office by April 20th, 2018. Volunteer Sheets and dumpster maps can also be found on our website (ozarkswaterwatch.org). All volunteers will receive a t-shirt and each family gets a coupon for a free night of camping at any Table Rock Lake Corps of Engineers campground! We love to see photos of your team! Please wear sturdy shoes, use a lifejacket while on docks or boats, dress appropriately, and be safe!

18th Annual, Table Rock Lake Shoreline Cleanup

April 7th, 2018

Basic instructions for our annual cleanup volunteers

1. Select a location you'd like to clean up that is either familiar to you, is where you have seen trash, or is a convenient location to you. We can also help you in selecting a location.
2. Pick up your teams' supplies from our [Kimberling City office](#)! We provide trash bags, gloves, snack bars, dumpsters and directions to our team captains to disperse to their volunteers on the day of the clean up. (Supplies can also be picked up at the Shell Knob Chamber of Commerce and the Dewey Short Visitors Center)
3. Download the [team and trash tracking sheets](#) and help us keep track of all the great work you and others do around the lake!
4. Grab some friends, family, neighbors – and hit the shoreline to pick up trash during the event! Dumpsters are available Friday - Monday
5. Turn in your Team Sheets when you're done to help us track the trash and get a fabulous t-shirt for each person on your team as well as a camping voucher (one per family) for use at any of the Table Rock Lake Corps of Engineers campgrounds for this season!
6. We will be at the OWW Office on Saturday, April 7th from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm. We will have supplies before you clean and t-shirts after you return. T-shirts can be picked up at our office until April 27th. We may be able to deliver shirts to Shell Knob and Dewey Short by arrangement if you contact us by April 13th.
